## **Food Parcel Support**

With all of your time and effort as volunteers we have managed to provide <u>**140**</u> Food Packages in November to those who have found themselves in food crisis, many thanks to everyone involved. The impact we continue to make can never truly be measured.

### **New Fundraising Team**

Many of you may know that our funds reached an all time low this August, due to an increase in demand for our support. To turn this situation around we created a fundraising team. These fantastic individuals are seeking out new and exciting ways to increase the funds and ensure we can continue with our amazing work. They are supported by many regular volunteers with a interest in fundraising. Over the last few months we have raised the following:

- Tesco Collection £80.35 plus a carload of food
- St Columb Light turn on £135
- Asda token collection £500

#### Grants

He has offered to research and apply for some Grants through Transformation Cornwall, with the hope of accessing some vital funds on our behalf. These funds are for use on Foodbank equipment and day to day running costs. Things we do not like to spend money donated for food on i.e. clothing, equipment, stationary, expenses etc. We have already managed to reinstate the Crisis fund, through his efforts. A fund dedicated to supporting our clients beyond food where required, exact expenditure opportunities for this fund are being investigated as I type.


### **New Leads and Treasurer**
