- Communicating with other team members
- At times you may be required to support our deliveries team taking food parcels to our users in the community

- Physically fit able to lift crates packed with up to 15kg of food stuffs
- Ability to listen and engage with people from a diverse range of backgrounds and experiences
- Ability to get on with others and be part of a team as well as completing some tasks independently
- A willingness to learn about our organisation and our place within the Trussell Trust and align to our campaigns
